HARDIN COUNTY’S MOTION TO RECONSIDER FINAL DECISION AND ORDER  
AND  
JOINDER IN “THE COUNTIES” MOTION TO RECONSIDER FINAL DECISION AND  
ORDER

COMES NOW, Intervenor, Hardin County, by and through the undersigned Hardin County Attorney, and in support of its Motion to Reconsider Final Decision and Order and Joinder in “The Counties” Motion to Reconsider Final Decision and Order, states:

On June 25, 2024, the Iowa Utilities Board (n/k/a Commission) issued a Final Decision and Order in this matter. Hardin County hereby joins the motion to reconsider filed by “The Counties” and adopts and restates herein all arguments in their motion. Further, Hardin County specifically and independently seeks reconsideration relative to the following:

1. The Commission failed to address Hardin County’s request for findings and an order requiring Summitt Carbon Solutions, LLC (hereinafter SCS), to comply with drainage district permitting in Hardin County pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 468.
2. The Commission failed to address Hardin County’s request for findings and an order limiting the scope of SCS’s pipeline permit applicatoin to exclude carbon capture facilities.
3. The Commission decision acknowledges and expects SCS’s continued compliance with Hardin County’s permitting requirements as they relate to county rights-of-way and infrastructure, but the Commission fell short of ordering SCS’s compliance.
